

OWEN COUNTY ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. 2

FISCAL COURT OF OWEN COUNTY, KENTUCKY

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION OF
ELECTIONEERING AT THE POLLS ON ELECTION DAY.

WHEREAS, KRS 117.235 prohibits electioneering at all polling places on election day unless authorized by the fiscal court; and,

WHEREAS, it is now deemed desirable to revoke the authorization for electioneering by any ordinance or resolution previously adopted by the fiscal court of Owen County authorizing electioneering at polls on election day; and,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF OWEN, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY;

1. As provided by KRS 117.235 on and after the effective date of this ordinance, no person shall do any electioneering at the polling place on election day. Electioneering shall include the displaying of signs, the distribution of campaign literature, cards or hand bills, the soliciting of signatures to any petition, or the solicitation of votes for or against any candidate or question on the ballot in any manner.

2. As provided by KRS 117.995, any person who violates any provision of KRS 117.235 related to prohibited activities on election day after he or she has been notified of such provisions by the sheriff of the election precinct shall be fined not more than \$50.00 for each offense.


3. As used in this ordinance and as used in KRS 117.235, the term "at the polling place" shall mean, and is construed to mean, the entire area within five hundred (500) feet of the voting machine being used, in the precinct on election day for the casting of ballots for that election.

4. This ordinance shall be effective on and after the date of its final passage.
