ORDINANCE NO. 3

FISCAL COURT OF OWEN COUNTY, KENTUCKY

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE REAPPORTIONMENT OF
MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT BOUNDARIES.

WHEREAS, now the magisterial districts are mapped off in area; and,


WHEREAS, the population difference between the largest district and the smallest is now two thousand one hundred and eight (2,108); and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 29 of the Kentucky Acts requires all counties to redistrict according to population after the 1980 census; and,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF OWEN, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY;

THEREFORE, the following precincts shall become magisterial districts following the adoption of this ordinance:

1. North Owenton, New Liberty, Jonesville, and Bromley.
Population 2,237;
2. Owenton, Inc. and South Owenton.
Population 2,227;
3. Hesler, Bethany, New Columbus, and Lusby Mill.
Population 2,254;
4. Monterey, Gratz, and Wheatley.
Population 2,212.
