

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE CLOSING OF ROADS

WHEREAS: The Owen County Fiscal Court has determined that there is a need to close Two Mile Road, 4.4 miles that runs from State Hwy.227 North to county road New Liberty-Sparta.

WHEREAS: The Owen County Fiscal Court has determined that there is a need to close the Lock #3 Lane, 0.2 mile from Slippery Rock Road to the Kentucky River.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: By the Owen County Fiscal Court that after the Commissioners and the County Road Supervisor have reviewed the roads and a Public Hearing held at the Owen County Courthouse, on Friday, June 5th, 1992 at 2:00 pm and being no objections, it is hereby ordered by the Owen County Fiscal Court that: Two Mile Road, 4.4 miles; and Lock #3 Lane, 0.2 mile be closed to the public.

First reading approved by the Owen County Fiscal Court the 12th, day of May, 1992.

This ordinance will be considered for adoption at the regular scheduled Fiscal Court meeting June 9th, 1992, 7:00 pm.
