COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY  
OWEN COUNTY  
ORDINANCE # 104

All residences, mobile homes, offices, and businesses in Owen County, Kentucky located outside the corporate limits of the Cities of Owenton, Monterey, and Gratz, Kentucky are hereby required to have visible on the structure, or if structure is more than fifty (50) feet from the edge of the roadway (private, county or state maintained) or from the mail box, then posted at the entrance to the property, the numbered address of the road on which they are occupied as listed by the United States Postal Service. Said numbered address of each structure shall be at least three (3) inches high and at least one-half (1/2) inch wide, visible from both directions. The numbers must be affixed to the structure or to the mail box or in the absence of a mail box then on a post which is visible from the road and able to withstand the elements. The owner of said residence, office or business shall be responsible for placement of said numbered address within sixty (60) days of the passage of this Ordinance or within ten (10) days of new occupancy. If said numbered address is not placed within the above time period, the County will place the numbered address on the property and bill the charges to the owner.
