ORDINANCE #228

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING LONG RIDGE LANE, ALECIA COURT, AND ASHLEY COURT, LOCATED IN LONG RIDGE ESTATES, AS COUNTY ROADS AND AUTHORIZING MAINTENACE THEREON

WHEREAS, it is the intent and purpose of the Owen County Fiscal Court to make Long Ridge Lane, Alecia Court, and Ashley Court, located in Long Ridge Estate, as County Roads; and WHEREAS, the Owen County Fiscal Court on June 13, 2006, took action to approve Long Ridge Lane, Alecia Court, and Ashley Court, located in Long Ridge Estates, into the county maintenance system, once twenty percent (20%) of the lots are developed and other road regulations are met; and

WHEREAS, a previous County Judge Executive stated that Long Ridge Lane, Alecia Court, and Ashley Court, located in Long Ridge Estates, had met all the county requirements regarding the construction of subdivision roads to be included into the county road maintenance system, except the final topcoat surface; and

WHEREAS, proof as been provided that the final one inch surface blacktop was laid on Long Ridge Lane, Alecia Court, and Ashley Court, located in Long Ridge Estates in May, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the condition of the above mentioned roads are in compliance with the requirements of the Owen County Road Regulations; and

WHEREAS, establishing these roads as County Roads will promote the general health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Owen County, Kentucky.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF OWEN COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

That Long Ridge Lane (0.4880 mile), Alecia Court (0.0880 mile), and Ashley Court (0.0730 mile), located in Long Ridge Estates, as dedicated in Plat Cabinet 1, Page 434, and more

particularly described in the attached description, and plat copy, which is referenced herein and incorporated herewith (as Attachment 1), shall be incorporated into the Owen County Road Maintenance System.

Upon introduction and given first reading before the Owen County Fiscal Court on the 24th day of November, 2020 and a motion having been made by Magistrate Spurgeon and seconded by Magistrate Bowling and following discussion the same was approved as the first reading.
